## THE BREEDERS CUP – THOROUGHBRED RACING'S CHAMPIONSHIP RACES (15)

The Summit (Theater Room), 1 Perry Rd., SS

Five consecutive weekdays: 9:30-11am

1. Tuesday-October 29: Introduction to the Breeders Cup and basic handicapping
2. Wednesday-October 30: Analysis of the first three races on Saturday November 2nd
3. Thursday-October 31: Analysis of races 4 to 6
4. Friday-November 1: Analysis of the last three races (usually the most exciting)
5. Monday-November 4: Review of the races and payoff to the contest winner

Since 1984, thoroughbred racing has conducted championship races in various divisions in the sport. Horses must be invited or qualify to run in these races. Currently run over two days (14 races) are contested to determine the champions each year. The Breeders Cup races attract horses from all over the world to this two-day extravaganza. The course will run for one week (5 sessions), the week before the races are run. This course is an opportunity to see the best thoroughbreds in the world compete against each other, analyze races, and to maybe go home with a profit. Each participant will receive emails with past performances and a handicapping spreadsheet developed by the course leader.

**Cost:** For a \$10 entry fee, participants will select a horse in each race, and based on a point system, the winner with the most points will take the pot.

**Leader:** Horse racing has been Bill Robeson's principal hobby for the past 59 years. He's taught two courses on handicapping at ALL this past year including discussions of races leading up to the triple crown. This summer he's been leading groups to various activities at Saratoga Racecourse including backstretch tours, the racing museum and hall of fame and a local breeding farm.
